3.40pm	Balloon Pairs <i>Take 2 balloons of the same size, inflate one to ½ full, twist the end then sellotape it to a drinking straw. Ask a friend to hold it so the air doesn't escape. Inflate second balloon to ¼ full, twist the end of this then sellotape to other end of straw. Let go of twists, what do you think will happen?</i>

4.20pm	Absorption Flowers <i>Draw a large flower on a sheet of paper – a daisy shape works best. Colour one side with wax crayon. Fold in petals at the base of the centre. Put non-coloured side down in bowl of water and watch. Why do the petals open? Try different types of paper and sizes of flower to compare speed that flowers open.</i>
